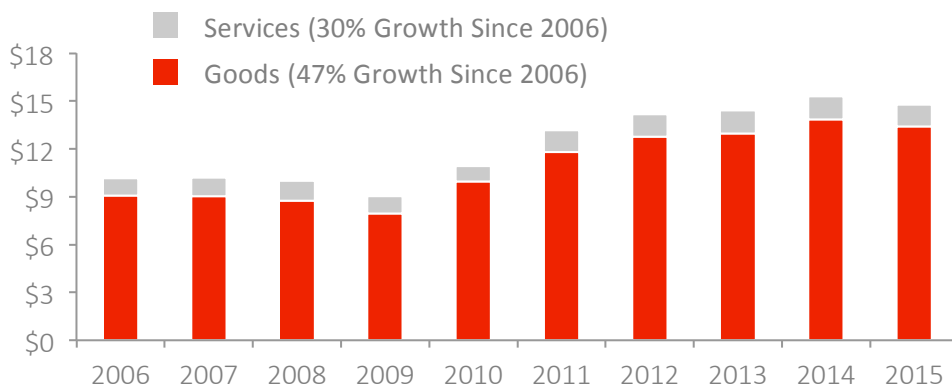

Share of Tennessee Exports Sent to NAFTA Partners for Select Sectors, 2015

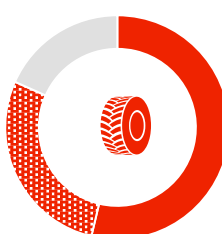
