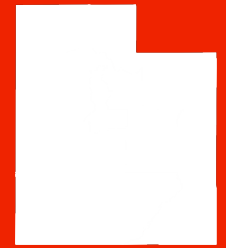


Utah Has a Real Economic Stake in Negotiations to Modernize NAFTA

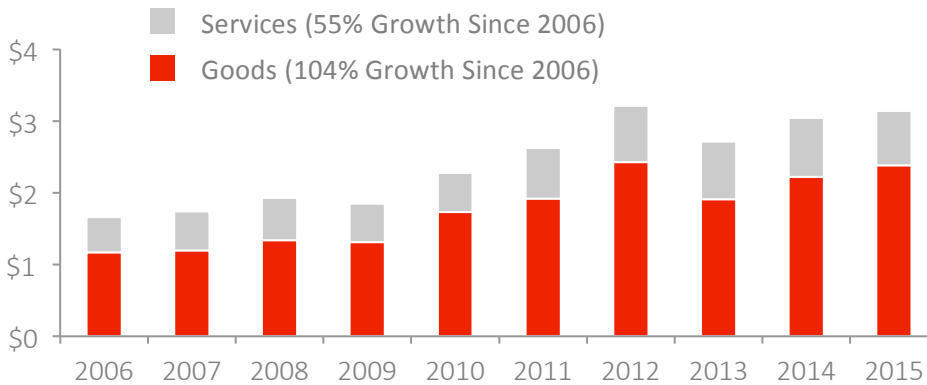

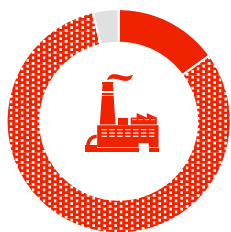

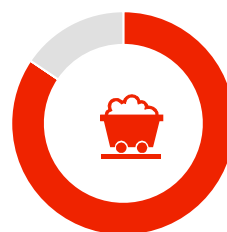
